THE COURT FEES (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1996

1. These Rules may be cited as the court fees (Amendment) Rules, 1996 and shall be read as one with the Court Fees, Rules 1964 herein referred to as the Principal Rules

2. The Principal Rules are amended in rule 8 by deleting sub-rule (5) and substituting for it the following new subrule—

"(5) No Fees shall be payable by a person who has been granted legal Aid Scheme of either the Faculty of law, University of Dar es Salaam, the Tanganyika Law Society or the Tanzania Women Lawyers' Association (TAWLA) in respect of proceedings instituted by or against such person except that if he is successful in the proceedings the court shall direct him to pay up the necessary court fees"

THE ELECTIONS (ELECTION PETITIONS) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1996

1. These Rules may be cited as the Elections (Election Petitions) (Amendment) Rules, 1996 and shall be read as one with the Elections (Election Petitions) Rules 1971 herein referred to as the Principal Rules.

2. The Principal Rules are hereby amended in rule 11 by deleting sub-rule (4) and substituting for it the following new sub-rule—

"(4) No security for costs shall be payable by a petitioner who has been granted legal aid under the Legal Aid Scheme of either the Faculty of Law, University of Dar es Salaam, the Tanganyika Law Society or the Tanzania Women Lawyers Association"
