

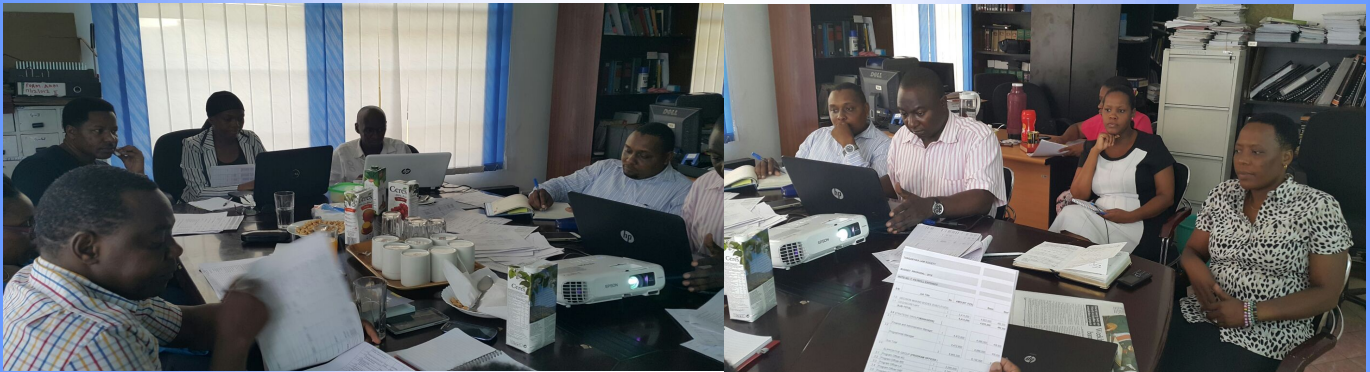

ETHICS COMMITTEE



*The National Ethics Committee met on Thurs-
day 21st January 2016 to deliberate and re-
solve ethical issues submitted by aggrieved
parties. Five cases were discussed and deliberated on.*

CONSTITUTION & LEGAL AFFAIRS' COMMITTEE

*This week the Constitution and Legal Affairs Com-
mittee met twice to make analysis of the Public
Procurement Act and its Regulations (submitted by
the Ministry of Finance and Planning), Proposed
Amendments to the Advocates Act (submitted by
the Ministry of Constitution and Legal Affairs) and
Several Judiciary Rules i.e the Probate and Ad-
ministration Rules, the Court broker Rules, Plea
Bargaining Rules, Small Claim Rules and the Ad-
vocates Disciplinary Rules (as submitted by the
Chief Justice). The comments emanated from these
meetings have been forwarded to the respective
Ministries and Judiciary.*
