NOTICE ON ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TANGANYIKA LAW SOCIETY (TLS) ZONES AND CHAPTERS

Notice is hereby given that the Governing Council of the Tanganyika Law Society sitting in its Extra Ordinary Meeting held on Friday, 13th March, 2020 the TLS Secretariat in Dar es Salaam has, among other things, resolved to establish 7 Tanganyika Law Society Zones and 6 new chapters in addition to the existing Chapters as per section 17A of the Tanganyika Law Society Cap 307 as amended.

7. SOUTHERN ZONE.
