RESOLUTIONS MADE DURING THE SOCIETY'S GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 15TH AND 16TH APRIL 2021 AT THE AICC IN ARUSHA.

Agenda item no. 3: To Receive for Adoption Annual reports of the Council and Audit Financial Reports for the year 2019 and 2020.

Resolved that the Financial Reports be circulated to members 14 days prior to the meeting to give members ample time to review and scrutinize the same.

Resolved further that the Governing Council should allow members to submit their queries on financial reports 7 days after receiving the same so that detailed answers are prepared in advance to assure that members' queries are responded effectively during the General Meeting.

Resolved further that there should be a well-established link between the Governing Council and the Society's Chapter for coordination of the approved activities of the Society and the budget of the Society.

Resolved further that the Society's budget should be shared to members for their information.

The General Meeting also resolved that Council and Secretariat should allocate more time for discussion of financial reports in the General Meeting's programme to allow effective discussion and deliberation on Society's financial matters before adoption.

Resolved that in future, the Council reports should reflect all the implemented activities of the Society in details including all the challenges encountered during the implementation of the said activities for the record purpose.

The General Meeting resolved that the Society should be proactive in protective Rule of law and good governance in the Country and should initiate reforms in oppressive laws.

Resolved, in respect of the CLE Seminars, that evaluation should be done to assess the effectiveness of CLE seminars to ascertain whether they serve the intended purpose.

Resolved further that the organized CLE seminars should reflect the diversity of the profession.

It was further resolved that the Wakili House should be utilized as an investment asset and the Secretariat offices should be squeezed to give more room for tenants.

The General Meeting also resolved that the Governing Council to formulate members' grievances mechanism so as to allow members with complaints /grievances to refer their matters for discussion instead of sharing the same on Social media platforms.

Resolved that members should refrain from embarrassing each other or using insulting and unethical words towards each other on social media.

Resolved further that, Ethics Committee should be able to deal with any member who act in unethical manner on members' social media groups so as to maintain order and professionalism during members' discussion on social media.

The General Meeting resolved to adopt the Financial Audit Reports and Annual Council reports for the year 2019 and 2020.
