What is AYL?

AYL is a forum established by the Council with the aim of advising the Council on legal practice relating to young lawyers.

What are the Objects of the AYL?

Objects of the AYL are to advise the Council on legal practice relating to young lawyers;

- to create a platform for young lawyers to table their concerns and issues affecting their practice and welfare;
- to cultivate development of young lawyers' professional growth and ethics;
- to foster equal opportunities in participation and inclusion of young lawyers to Society's programs and structure;
- and to promote constructive discussion on young lawyers' welfare within and outside the Society and engage in addressing them for the benefit of young lawyers and the Society.

Who is a member of the AYL?

A member of the AYL is a member of the Society (TLS) who:

- has attained the age of thirty five years or below; and**
- has been practicing for less than five years.**

Where are the young lawyers represented?

- At the Council of the Society** – The Chairperson of the AYL is a Council member
- At the Zonal Executive Committee** – The member of the AYL Executive Committee is a member of the Zonal Executive Committee; and
- At the AGM** – A young lawyer elected by respective Chapter members to represent young lawyers of the said Chapter at the AGM.

The AYL Annual Meeting will be conducted at the Lush Garden Hotel in Arusha on Wednesday, 14th April, 2021 from 02.00PM to 03.30PM.
